



Outdoor Painting in Oils

Oil paints and painting panels will be provided, but class participants will need to bring their own outdoor painting gear.

Here's what to bring*:

- * Easel and palette suitable for outdoor use (French easel, pochade box, Guerrilla box or whatever you have)**
- * Brushes (long bristle flats in a variety of sizes from #2 - #10)**
- * Odorless Turpenoid or Gamsol in a hanging brush washer**
- * Medium (50/50 mix of cold pressed linseed oil and Gamsol in a small metal palette cup)**
- * Paper towels (Viva is best)**
- * Small trash bag**
- * Bug and tick repellent**
- * Umbrella for shade (optional)**

If you're an experienced painter with your own materials preferences, you're welcome to bring your own paints and panels. The materials fee will be waived. Recommended colors: Cadmium yellow light, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Ivory Black and Titanium White. You'll need about six 5" X 7" inexpensive canvas panels and two 8" x 10" or 9" x 12" panels.
