

Outdoor Painting in Oils

Oil paints and painting panels will be provided, but class participants will need to bring their own outdoor painting gear.

Here's what to bring*:

- * Easel and palette suitable for outdoor use (French easel, pochade box, Guerrilla box or whatever you have)
- * Brushes (long bristle flats in a variety of sizes from #2 #10)
- * Odorless Turpenoid or Gamsol in a hanging brush washer
- * Medium (50/50 mix of cold pressed linseed oil and Gamsol in a small metal palette cup)
- * Paper towels (Viva is best)
- * Small trash bag
- * Bug and tick repellant
- * Umbrella for shade (optional)

If you're an experienced painter with your own materials preferences, you're welcome to bring your own paints and panels. The materials fee will be waived. Recommended colors: Cadmium yellow light, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Ivory Black and

Titanium White. You'll need about six 5" X 7" inexpensive canvas panels and two 8" x 10" or 9" x 12" panels.
